

Brief for visitors – with the request for attention

Prerequisites for access by visitors are, in particular, **proof of a negative** coronation test or **complete vaccination**, as well as the provision of contact details in the visitor list and a completed self-declaration form. On-site training on the **Vinnolit hygiene rules** is also required.

1 Proof of a negative test

For access, the visitor must present a valid negative coronal test in digital or paper form:

- PCR test not older than 48h
- Antigen rapid test (performed by qualified personnel) not older than 24h

Alternatively, evidence of complete vaccination can be provided after 2.

2 Proof of immunization:

Individuals are considered **fully vaccinated** 14 days after all necessary COVID-19 vaccine doses have been administered, thus, on day 15:

- Two doses of vaccine are required for BioNTech/Pfizer (Comirnaty), Moderna (COVID-19 Vaccine Moderna), and AstraZeneca (Vaxzevria) vaccines.
- With the Johnson & Johnson vaccine (COVID-19 Vaccine Janssen), only one vaccine dose is required.

Convalescents who have undergone PCR-confirmed SARS-CoV-2 infection are also considered **fully vaccinated** 14 days after 1 COVID-19 vaccination with the above vaccines, provided the infection occurred at least 28 days to a maximum of 6 months ago.

Required proof:

- Original proof of vaccination in paper form, e.g. international yellow vaccination card, or digital proof of vaccination recognized by official bodies, e.g. in CovPass app or Corona warning app - in German, English, French, Italian or Spanish.
- Convalescents additionally require proof of a positive PCR test dating back at least 28 days and a maximum of six months, in paper or digital form.

If this evidence cannot be provided, a negative coronal test according to 1 must be submitted.

3 Entry in visitor list and video training of Vinnolit hygiene rules

Visitors must sign the visitor list at the reception desk with their contact details for tracing possible infection chains and show the completed self-declaration form Attachment 01. The visitor is obliged to wear an FFP2 mask in the Vinnolit area of validity. If this is / cannot be complied with, entry to the area of validity is to be refused.

Visitors will be trained at the reception about the regulations, in particular the regulation on infection protection and the Vinnolit hygiene rules with the help of a video. The training will be documented.
